
<Pre><Preparation for Entry and Quarantine>



Before Departure

Step 1. Apply for Visa or K-ETA (Korea Electronic Travel Authorization)

- Based on your passport information, nationality, and the duration of your stay, you need to get a visa to enter Korea. You can find which visa suits you at Korea Visa Portal (www.visa.go.kr). Please confirm again with Korean diplomatic missions or consulates.
- K-ETA Application for Nationals of Visa Waiver and Designated Visa-Free Countries

 Following the implementation of K-ETA, nationals of 112 countries/regions who were eligible for visa-free entry now should apply for K-ETA for the issuance of the boarding pass. (As of 1 June 2022)

*If you apply for a K-ETA and receive approval, you are exempted from the visa application.

| How to Apply | Apply for the K-ETA at least 72 hours prior to boarding the flight on the K-ETA official website (www.k-eta.go.kr) or mobile App (K-ETA) K-ETA application by proxy is available (one person can apply up to a total of 30 people and make the payment at once). |

| Note | Those with K-ETA approval can go through entry immigration more conveniently, as they will be exempted from submitting the arrival card upon entry. K-ETA is not a Visa. K-ETA approval does not guarantee admission to the Republic of Korea. A Korea Immigration Service officer at a port of entry will have the final determination. The information entered cannot be modified once the application is submitted. |

• UNLP (United Nations Laissez-Passer) holders are exempted from the visa and K-ETA.

Step 2. Receive Negative Result of PCR/RAT Test for COVID-19

All entrants who do not hold a certificate of negative* PCR/RAT test result for COVID-19 (including those who hold a non-conforming certificate) shall be restricted from getting on board the aircraft. (Regardless of vaccination status) *The test result if "INDETERMINATE", "UNCLEAR", or "POSITIVE", the relevant result is invalid.

| Required Items | Name*, Birth Date**, Test method, Test date, Test Result, Date of Issuance, and the name of the testing center should be included in the test result. |
| | *The name on the test result needs to match the name on the passport **Passport number or national ID number is acceptable instead of date of birth |
| Language | The test method must be written in English *In case of other languages, a translation certificate must be accompanied. |

Step 3. Input Quarantine Information Using Q-Code

Q-Code is an advanced input system of quarantine information to shorten the time for quarantine inspection and provide the conveniences overseas entrants require upon entry to the Republic of Korea.

All participants should print out negative results and bring with you.

Upon Arrival at the Airport

Step 1. Take a PCR Test

- All entrants must take a PCR Test within 3 days of arrival in Korea.
 - All Participants will make a reservation yourself for the PCR test depending on your flight schedule and landing terminal.
 - You can make a reservation online at https://safe2gopass.com/index
 - Even if you are not booked in advance, it can be take within 3 days of arrival, DGCA57 staff will support the PCR test.
 - The DGCA protocol staff welcomes all participants from the reception hall and escorts you to the PCR test center and shuttle bus.
 - Cost of the test fee shall be paid by the host state.

Step 2. Move to Hotel and Wait for the Result

- We recommend minimizing outside contact before receiving the PCR test result.
- If you get a positive result, you will be required to self-isolate for 7 days.
- If the symptoms of the participants are severe, we will manage to move the designated hospital (airport and hotel surrounding).
