SUMMARY

CASP-AP has provided training and capacity building initiatives in the region during the period February to July 2022 in accordance with the approved CASP-AP Interim Work Plan. During the five months CASP-AP has concentrated on providing virtual Aviation Security Workshops and Courses, that were prioritized according to monthly themed activities – Quality Control, Risk, Programmes and Cybersecurity. Seven workshops/courses were offered during this period, with 172 participants attending from 19 Member States/Administrations. In July, CASP-AP partnered with IATA to present a Cybersecurity Awareness seminar which was attended by 115 delegates.

TRAINING AND CAPACITY BUILDING

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Despite the on-going challenges relating to travel restrictions, CASP-AP now has a full complement of staff and since November 2021 has been working diligently to redirect resources to Member priorities, increase the availability of virtual training events and update all documentation. This involved proactive work in relation to the proposed Amendment 18 to Annex 17, a review of member needs relating to facilitation and a review of guidance materials and Quality Control assistance tools.
- 1.2 CASP-AP will continue to support Member States/Administrations via virtual activities until July 2022. Starting August 2022, CASP-AP will adjust the training and capacity building activities towards face-to-face missions and in-classroom training.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 Based on the results of the November 2021 Membership Needs Survey, CASP-AP has offered workshops/courses/seminars in a themed monthly format. All training activity has been over-subscribed, highlighting the need for training that is regionally focused.
